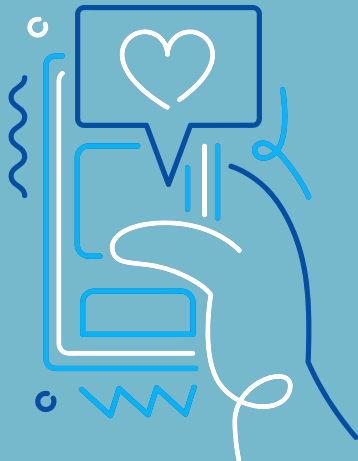

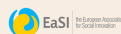

WHY MENTOR+?

Research in the field of adolescent delinquency has shown there is a positive correlation between mentoring relationships and increased social capital, such as self-esteem, education, and employment achievements.
